<u>Parent Forum</u> – Facilitated discussion among parents to share ideas, express concerns, and obtain insight on topics of relevance as guided by participant interest. (*Varies by year and program schedule*)

<u>Movie Screening</u> – Opportunity to gather with others at a central venue to view selected film pertaining to education, child development, and/or parenting topics. (*Screenagers*, January 2017)

... for Member School Administrators and Students (2 student participants selected by each member school)

<u>Upper School Student Leader Breakfast</u> – Student leaders take part in moderated, confidential peer-to-peer dialogue, sharing perspectives and exploring issues/solutions in both large and small group settings.

<u>Middle School Student Leader Breakfast</u> - Seventh grade students discuss issues of relevance/concern in a moderated yet self-directed forum, with a concurrent session for accompanying administrators.

<u>Upper School Dean of Students Program</u> – Confidential meeting among upper school Deans of Students, highlighting topics/issues discussed at the student leader breakfast as well as any other selected matters.

<u>Middle School Administrators/Counselors Breakfast</u> – Concurrent session for administrators who accompany seventh grade students to the middle school student leader breakfast.

<u>PCW Orientation</u> - A 'must' for member school PA Presidents and Parent PCW Representatives to learn about all PCW has to offer for member schools during the academic year (event also has featured speaker).
